Minutes of last meeting held on the 18<sup>th</sup> of January 24

The minutes from last meeting were signed as correct.

Correspondence

1. Bank mandate was signed by the councillors and the clerks to send to HSBC.
2. Report from Cl Gwennol Ellis – it was stated that the Crown hill is now open to traffic and it was stated that the company involved with the work MWT have planted some flowers in the wall as a gift from them, the clerk to thank the company for their kindness. More complaint have come forward with the parking of three cars on the main road, cl Gwennol Ellis to look into and start the long process of laying yellow lines. It has been reported that speed of lorries through the village is a problem this is to be monitored and if it does exist then may be we could ask the Go Safe van to come to the village, or if there are volunteers out locally with speed gun this is also an option, were training will be given.
3. UKSPF the application for grant to do the feasibility study has been successful £4,471.00 was granted. The clerk to start on the process of inviting Marc Roberts to come and meet the councillors.
4. Urdd Gobaith Cymru Conwy asking for a donation no donation given.
5. Conwy B Council a report received after an annual inspection of the play area by the Gro, it stated rooted timber was taken away, and due to lack of funding will not be replaced.
6. Conwy B Council – annual report by the Conwy Council, stating that we as community council fund £200 towards the summer play scheme in Cerrig y Drudion and £500 towards the upkeep of the Uwchaled Hub.
7. Laptop - a new laptop has been bought for the admin work £200 part payment with Cerrig y Drudion community council.
8. Lelo Skip hire an invoice received for £312.00 was paid.
9. Welsh Water an invoice received for £54.24 was paid.
10. Crown Inn letter received and noted.
11. Bute Energy - an invitation from them to come and meet us in our next meeting. It was noted that Helen Jones did not take any discussion on this matter.
12. Conwy B Council precept - it was decided to raise the amount this year to £7,000 due to the rising cost of upkeep.
13. Electricity used for the Christmas tree in the village, Dewi and Haf wish that we sent a donation to Cerrig y Drudion school instead, a donation of £50 was given.
14. Audit Wales two invoices received for the auditing of accounts, £1380.00 for 2021 (full audit) and £200 for 2022. Were paid.
15. Conwy B Council payment of £2000.00 received the final precept for 2023.
16. Denbighshire Council letter to be sent to complain about the condition of the roads at Bod Petruall during the snow and ice.
17. Brenig Wind Farm two applications for grant have been submitted one for a new notice board at bus shelter for £598.00 and reinstate the playing field by the Gro £4,500.00 (two quotes were received) the clerk Carol Humphreys declared her interest in one of the quotes and did not take any part in the quotes (quotes were sent to Gethin Jones).
