Correspondence.

1. Fire Works - £165.00 were collected on the night of bonfire proceeds towards Ty Gobaith.
2. A payment was made to Gethin Jones for the fireworks £324.00. (the clerk has made an application from the Elusen G M Bodtegir wind farm for money towards buying the fireworks no correspondence received yet.)
3. Conwy Borough Council letter received asking for £550 donation towards the Uwchaed Library in Cerrig y Drudion up keep. All vote in favour to support the library.
