**Air Ambulance Wales** – asking for a donation - none given.

**Gethin Morris River Dee Officer** – letter stating that the work in the river is completed and the fresh pearl mussel will be introduced in the near future. Also two picnic tables have been installed at the Gro, and a Text board will be installed in the near future.

**Conwy B Council** – a letter stating 2026 annual costings to community council next year, it was noted that Conwy have applied for a grant towards replacing the wooden trail at the Gro. Childrens playing session were noted but not relevant to our community in Llanfihangel. Community Libraries are a concern a high rise in the donation wanted - cll Gwennol Ellis will look into this matter, risen from £500 to £692.00.
